Beautification – In addition to the items approved at the September 17 meeting, the commission discussed the possibility of investing in sidewalk medallions, additional hanging baskets and ornamental sidewalks.

2019 - 2020 Budget – Pubic Way Aesthetics

A status update was provided for the 2019 beautification items that were approved at the September 17 commission meeting.:

- Paint 11 light poles 39th Ward Office– requested October 1.
- Perform tree pit maintenance: Chicago Department of Transportation completed
- Procure 13 new sidewalk planters and install winter foliage in process
- Repair the roofline lighting on the Polish National Alliance building in process
- Install winter foliage in 16 existing hanging baskets and 36 sidewalk planters in process, completed by 11/22
- Install decorative canvas banners on 5 light poles pending
- Lease public art from the Chicago Sculpture Exhibit for 2020 pending
